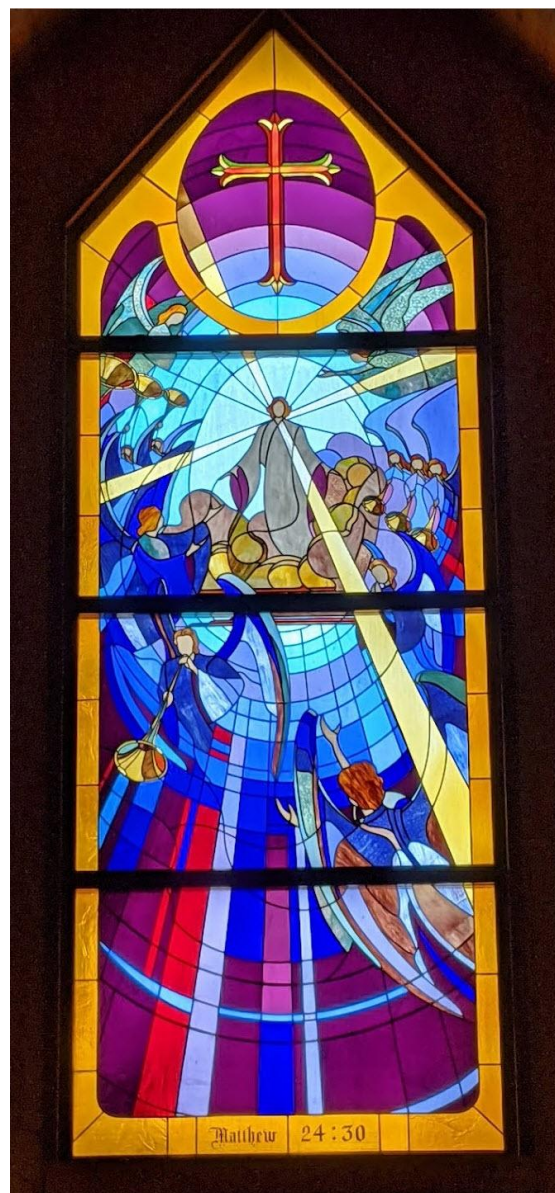

WORSHIP & EDUCATION

Worship

Coffee Hour - Come and enjoy some coffee, sweets and conversations prior to Worship Services at 9:00 a.m. on Sundays.

Worship services are held every Sunday at 10:00 a.m. All are welcomed at the Lord's table.

Adult Sunday School



For those who want to learn more about their faith or just get a better understanding of the Gospels, Adult Sunday School is held every Sunday (September through May) after Worship at approximately 11:15 a.m. in the Quilting Room (unless otherwise stated).

Children's Sunday School



The Children's Sunday School is held Sunday mornings from 9:15 to 9:45 a.m. prior to Worship. Sunday school starts in late September and runs through May. Classes are not held when children are on school breaks.

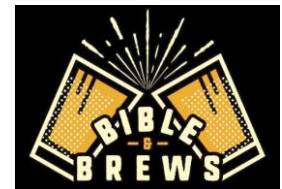
Bible Study



This is a review and discussion of the Readings and the Gospel for the coming Worship Service. Bible Study is held every Wednesday at 10:00 a.m. and runs until about 11:30 a.m. Coffee and sweets are provided.

Bible and Brew



This outing is held the second Monday of the month at The Trestle Stop in Hamilton from 5:30 to 8:00 p.m. What is Bible and Brew you ask? It is a fun evening enjoying food, drink and conversations on topics that are picked out of a jar. Some of the questions are religious, other are not, but all are thought provoking. Each person who picks a question gets to answer it first, then the others can make a comment as to what they would do, say or think regarding the question. Picking a question is not mandatory to attend and you can always pass. Enjoying yourself, though, is mandatory. There is a signup sheet at the round table.

Monthly Dinner Night Out



The third Saturday of the month is scheduled for our monthly dinner night out. Each month, someone chooses to be the coordinator and selects a restaurant. 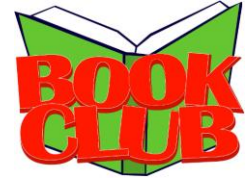
Quilting Group

Praise Team – Choir

Mandala Contemplative Prayer Group

Mandalas have been around throughout history as it represents the spiritual journey, starting from the outside to the inner core, through layers. The group meets every other month (February, April, June, August, October & December) on the second Monday of the month at 1:00 p.m.



God's Garden

Do you enjoy gardening and working with the soil? God's Garden is where a group of people meet just twice a month for an hour to maintain (and upgrade) the landscaping around the Church. Bring gloves and gardening tools if you have them. After the cleanup, coffee and a dessert are provided. There is a sign-up sheet at the round table to volunteer for the dessert, as well as the dates for the month. God's Garden meets on Tuesdays (two weeks apart) of each month at 10:00 a.m. (9:00 a.m. on hotter, summer days) from Spring through Fall.

All-Committee Meetings

There are several committees made up of members of the church that help run and maintain Immanuel Lutheran Church, such as Christian Education, Finance, Building & Property, Music, etc. The All-Committee meetings are held once a quarter on a Monday evening. A potluck is usually involved, too. You do not need to be on a committee to attend. If you are curious as to how things run at Immanuel, this is a good opportunity to check it out.

Other Non-Related Church Activities

Immanuel provides the rental of our building for outside venues. Currently, Zumba meets twice a week on Wednesdays at 6:00 p.m. and Saturdays at 10:00 a.m. The church charges a fee for participation for non-members.
